Information: Pot-luck dinner begins at 7pm on Friday night. Bring a dish to share and your own beverage, utensils, plates and napkins. An a capella sing is scheduled for Sunday night. All events are held in covered buildings (no smoking, please). Bring blankets or lawn chairs. Commute, or camp at the fairgrounds. Camping: Friday 3 PM to Monday 2 PM. The open field site can accommodate tents, pop-ups, vans, cars, and RVs. No campfires. There are showers and flush toilets. No pets. Bring clothes for any and all kinds of weather. Campground cooking may be done on propane/gas stoves, or charcoal grills. There are usually no commercial concessions at this festival.

Directions: Saratoga County Fairgrounds in Ballston Spa, NY. Take I-87 (the Northway) north to Exit 12. Take Route 67 west to the junction of Route 50. Turn right. Go through the village of Ballston Spa (through 3 traffic lights) and make a left onto Prospect Street. Go up the hill to the Saratoga County Fairgrounds. (Approximately 30 miles from Albany) see: website for maps and other information, including updates.

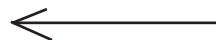
