Information: Pot-luck dinner begins at 7pm on Friday night. Bring a dish to share and your own beverage, utensils, plates and napkins. An a capella sing is scheduled for Sunday night. All events are held in covered buildings (no smoking, please). Bring blankets or lawn chairs. Commute, or camp at the fairgrounds. Camping: Friday 3 PM to Monday 2 PM. The open field site can accommodate tents, pop-ups, vans, cars, and RVs. Camping only in designated areas - please. No campfires. There are showers and flush toilets. No pets. Bring clothes for any and all kinds of weather. Campground cooking may be done on propane/gas stoves, or charcoal grills. There are usually no commercial concessions at this festival.

Directions: Saratoga County Fairgrounds in Ballston Spa, NY. Take I-87 (the Northway) north to Exit 12. Take Route 67 west to the junction of Route 50. Turn right. Go through the village of Ballston Spa (through 3 traffic lights) and make a left onto Prospect Street. Go up the hill to the Saratoga County Fairgrounds. (Approximately 30 miles from Albany) see: website for maps and other information, including updates.

last update - 12 Feb 2017

The fairground folks are getting more strict about several things, mostly about camper hookups: *(camp only in designated area)*

Hook-ups: There are no FULL hookups anywhere on the site.

Water: Please use splitter for water. By NYS Dept of Health regulation, backflow preventers must be on both sides.

Electricity: You are allowed only one plug-in per site. Additional plugs may be disconnected. There must be at least 3 feet between a camper and the breaker panel, and at least 10 feet between campers. If you overload the panel, and trip it frequently, it may not be reset.

Fires: Open fires are **not permitted**, no barbecuing within 25 feet of an awning. Fire lanes must be kept open at all times.

Black and gray water: There is no dumping station on the grounds. Discharging gray water on the grounds of adjacent property carries a fine of \$250, black water discharge carries a fine of \$1000. Pump-out service is available, but must be arranged in advance through the Fairground Office.

Picnic tables: Tables will be available. You may want to contact the Fairground Office prior to your event. Picnic tables located in the pavilions may be used there freely, but best not be moved out of the pavilion in which they were found.
